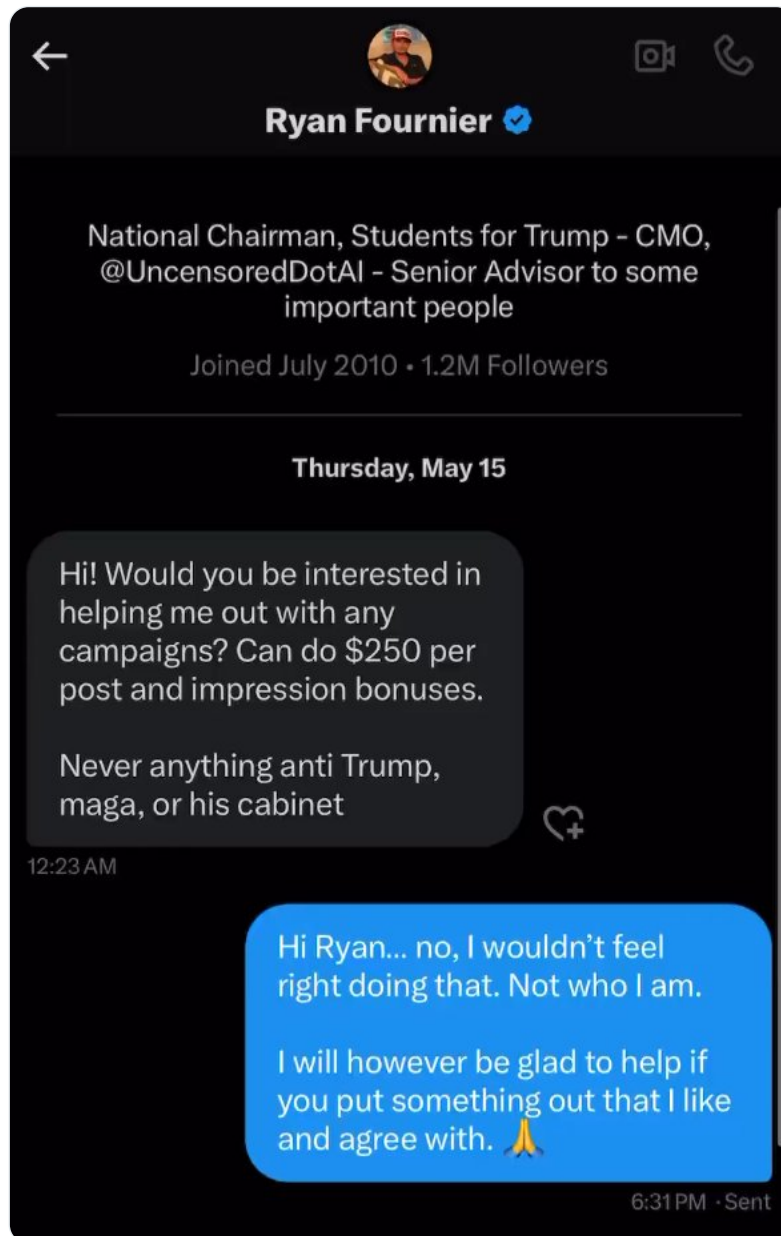
Marketing firms, crypto scammers, and political operatives are paying up to \$500 per post to accounts willing to shill their agenda. One scheme was exposed by pro-Trump account @MJTruthUltra, who leaked messages from political scammer @RyanAFournier.

Fournier offered “\$250 per post plus impression bonuses,” adding: “Never anything anti-Trump, MAGA, or his cabinet.” Amusingly, these rules are nearly identical to those given to Yevgeny Prigozhin’s trolls at Russia’s first troll farm, the “Internet Research Agency”.

Fournier himself once ran a crypto scam with a “Restore the Republic” coin, cashing out after pumping the price. He was also arrested in 2023 for allegedly beating up his girlfriend. In today’s MAGA world, these count as résumé highlights.

When Elon Musk acquired Twitter for the modest sum of 44 billion dollars, he promised to put an end to bots. However, three years later, the observation is alarming: the social network, renamed X, is more infested than ever. Worse, the bots proudly display their blue badge, proof that some pay to exist. Changpeng Zhao, aka CZ, former head of Binance and contributor to the purchase of Twitter, has just slammed the table: he wants a network populated by humans, not robots.



So whenever David posts, you should view his content through this lens.

When he claimed there was “no video content from the war in Ukraine” — one of the most well-documented conflicts in history over the last three years — who was paying him?

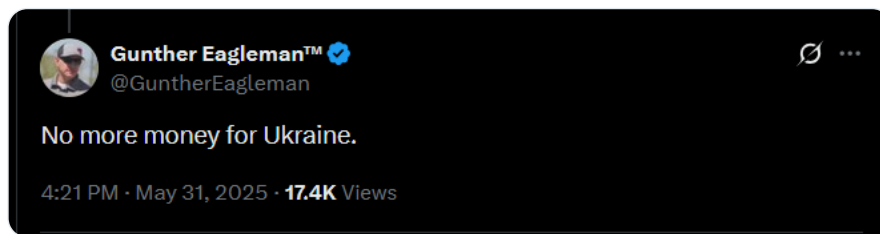

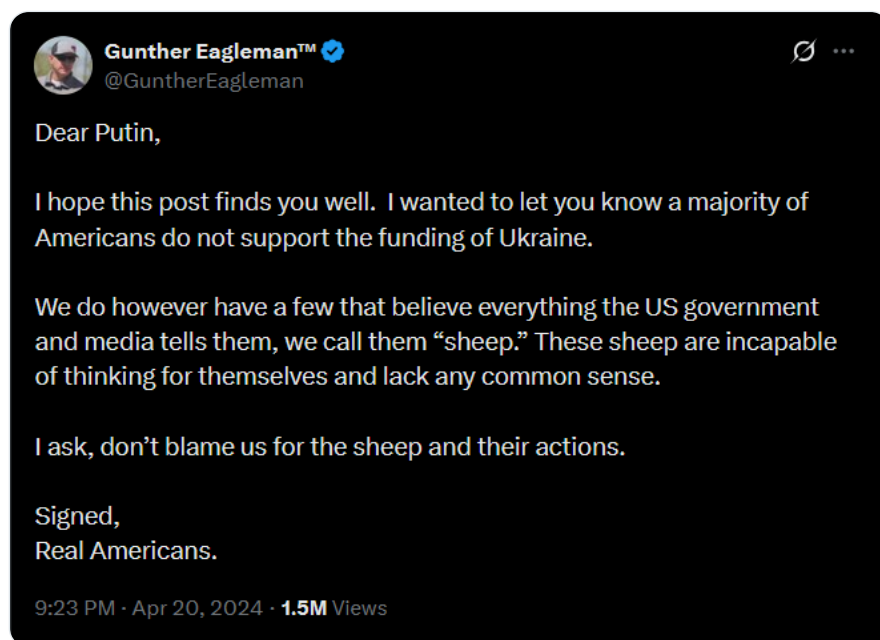



Elon Musk has said his \$44bn deal to buy Twitter may be in jeopardy due to a disagreement over the number of fake accounts on the social media platform.

Mr Musk tweeted that the deal "cannot move forward" unless Twitter backs up its claims that less than 5% of daily users are fake or spam accounts.

Twitter has defended its figures, adding that Mr Musk waived rights to "due diligence" to clinch the deal.

The spat has raised doubts about the takeover.

Analysts have speculated that Mr Musk may be looking for ways to renegotiate the price of the deal or walk away.

Mr Musk agreed the \$44bn (£34.5bn) deal to buy Twitter with its board in April, but last week Mr Musk said the deal was "on hold" while he sought details about fake accounts.

He has continued to press the issue in tweets and public appearances, while also hinting that he could seek a lower price.

On Tuesday, Mr Musk said Twitter boss Parag Agrawal had "publicly refused to show proof" that fewer than 5% of its accounts were fake, and said the deal "cannot move forward" until Mr Agrawal does show proof.

Mr Musk's tweet then appeared to be deleted.

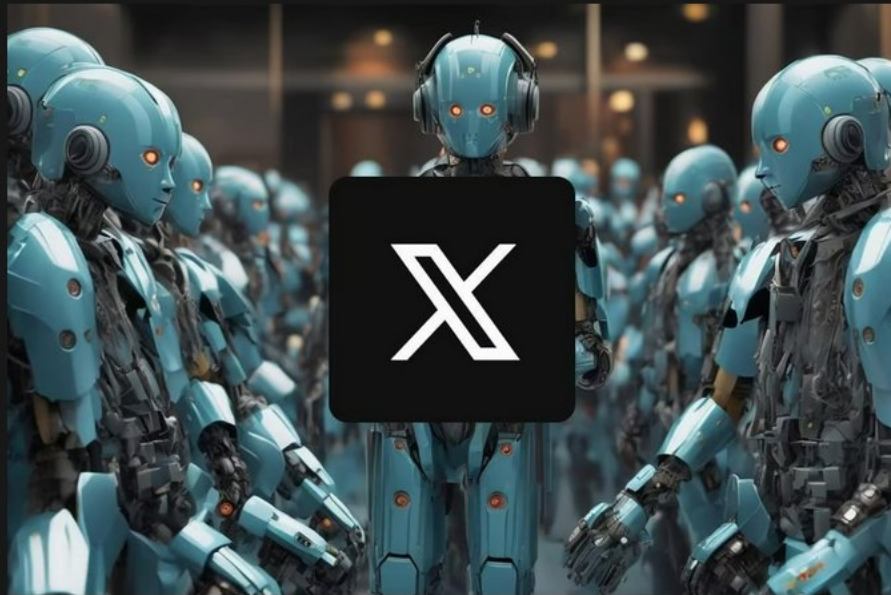

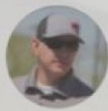

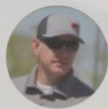
